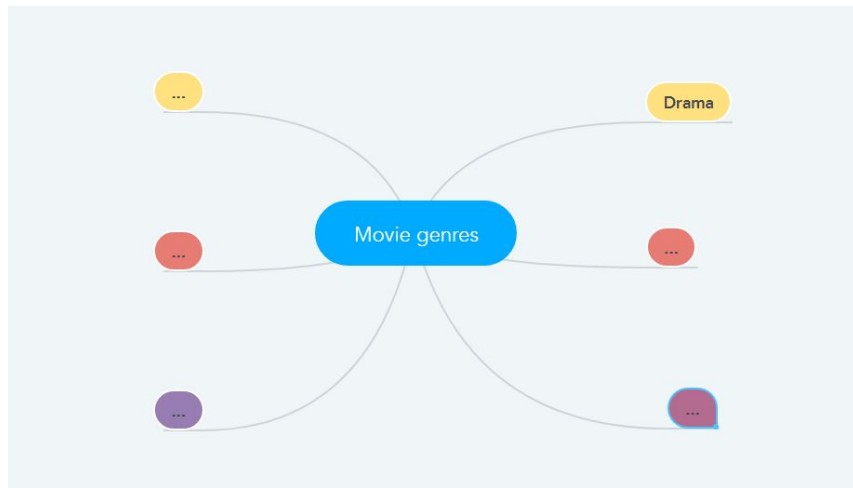


Movies Coming out in 2021

A) Answer the questions.

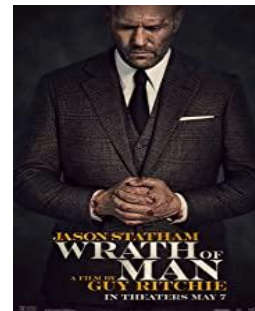
1. Look at the posters of the films. What do you think they are about?

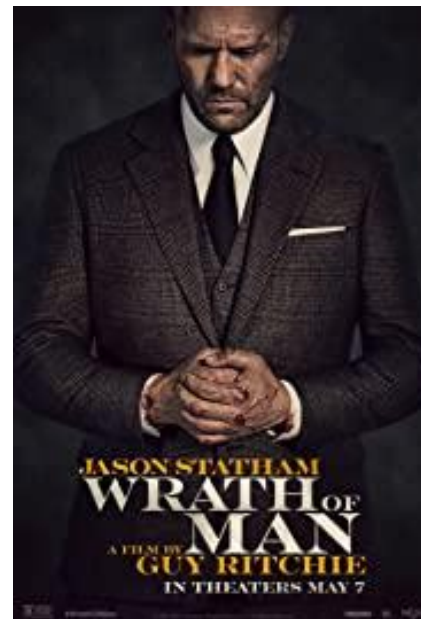
C) Do you still want to watch the movie you chose before reading the description? Have you changed your mind? Why/why not?

Task 6: Watching “Coming 2 America”

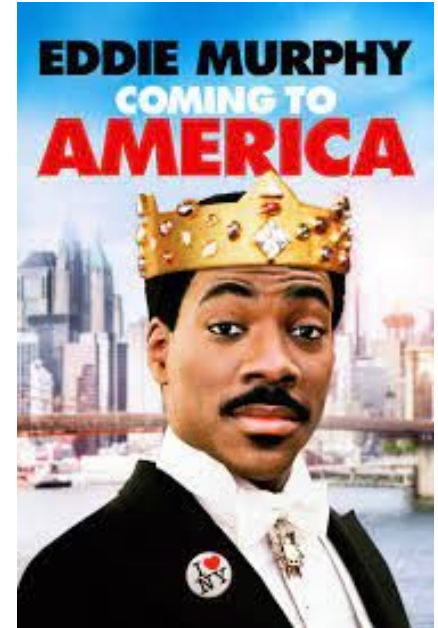
A) Watch the trailer of the film and order the sentences.

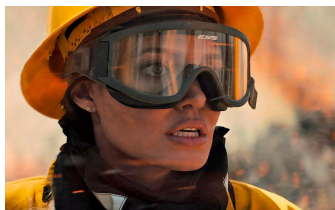
1. Do you enjoy watching comedy films? What is your favorite one?

4. What part of the trailer do you think was the funniest?



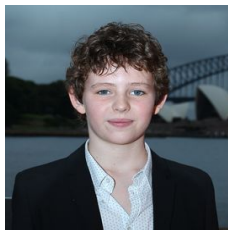
Task 7: Watching “Those who wish me dead”
