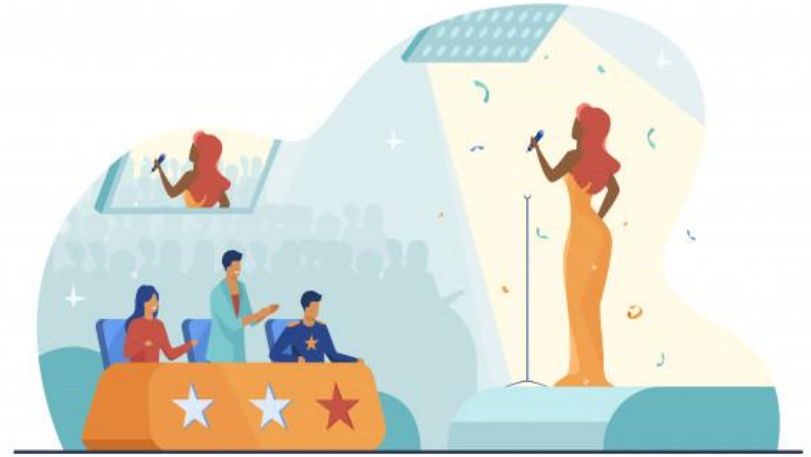


Eurovision 2020: Europe shine a light

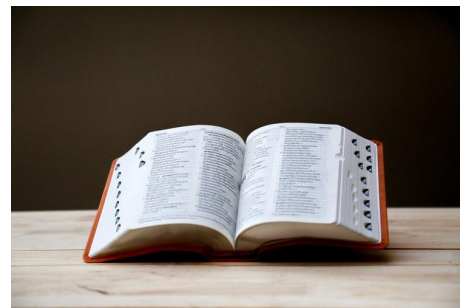
